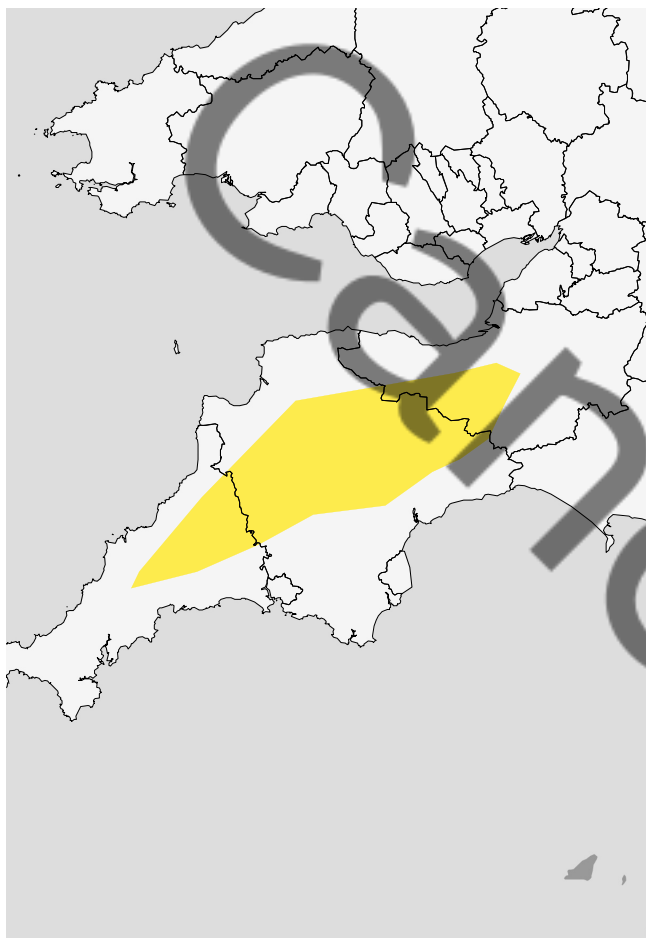

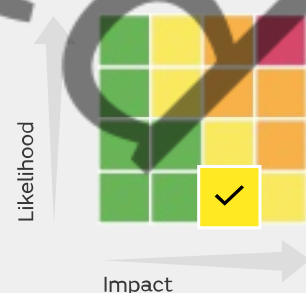
**Heavy showers may form during Friday afternoon.****What to expect**

- There is a small chance that homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- Where flooding occurs, delays or cancellations to train and bus services are possible

Further details

Whilst many parts of southwest England will see a dry day as conditions brighten up through Friday some heavy showers may form.

Where these do develop some large rainfall totals may fall in a short space of time with 40 mm of rain possible in 2 hours very locally. However, even a short distance away only very small rainfall amounts are expected.
