Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
A wet start across Northern Ireland and much of Scotland with gales or severe gales. During the day the rain and locally strong winds will move southeastwards, reaching southeast England during the afternoon. Brighter conditions will follow the rain, reaching most places later, but wintry showers are also expected over northern and northwestern Scotland. Winds easing for a time as the rain clears, but increasing again across Scotland later. Mild at first, but becoming colder during the day, and feeling colder in the wind.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Very windy on both Wednesday and Thursday with gales or severe gales and rain at times.
