Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Outbreaks of sleet and snow over central and southern England continuing southwards, with spell of snow for East Anglia and southeast England during morning. Widespread icy stretches likely. Drier, breezier weather already over northern areas will follow to all parts during day. Showers will develop, mainly in the northeast where they become wintry. Cold in the east but temperatures recovering in the west.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Further showery outbreaks of rain, sleet or snow in the east Saturday, spreading to central areas at times. Western parts drier, brighter and less cold. On Sunday snow showers continue in southeast, mainly dry but cold elsewhere.
