Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally cloudy in the west, with rain developing over western Scotland, becoming locally heavy later. Central and eastern areas should be dry with sunny spells, but becoming increasingly cloudy. Breezy generally and windy with some strong gusts over northeast England and southeast Scotland. Locally mild today and generally frost-free tonight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Remaining generally cloudy, but largely dry, in the west on Thursday, with rain over western Scotland. Brighter in the east. Wet, windy weather in the west overnight will affect eastern parts on Friday morning, with sunny spells and heavy, blustery showers following. Becoming windy. Some gales, especially in the north.
