

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Chilly with sunny spells and wintry showers, easing later. Showers most frequent in the north, with some further snow accumulation over higher ground, whilst further south they will mainly be wintry over hills. Breezy in the west. Clear spells overnight, allowing a widespread frost. However, some rain arriving over the far northwest by later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain, locally heavy, moving eastwards on Sunday, windy with gales in the west. Transient snow in the north, particularly over hills. Blustery showers following in the northwest. Cold, windy with gales, locally severe, and showers Monday. Showers wintry, especially over high ground and in the north.
