

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A cold start with icy stretches. Then a mix of rain, sleet and snow spreading southeastwards through the day. Snow likely to low levels across Scotland, and mostly over higher ground for northern England and Wales. A windy day. Rain and sleet clearing southeastwards overnight. Showers following, especially around coasts. The showers wintry at times. Frost and ice inland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Windy on Friday and feeling cold. A good deal of dry and bright weather, but scattered showers, mainly in the east, occasionally wintry. Largely fine and dry in the south on Saturday, but cloudy with outbreaks of rain in the north.
