

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Friday 05 Sep 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A rainband across parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland will move south to reach northern England later, then brighter with showers in Scotland. Further south, fog and low cloud slowly clearing, then dry almost everywhere with warm sunny spells. Rain in northern England will move slowly southwards overnight, but tend to fragment. Showers for Scotland, especially the north.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Still warm with sunny spells in the south on Saturday, but cooler conditions elsewhere with some heavy showers in Scotland, the north and east in particular. Dry for many on Sunday with some sunshine, but heavy rain is likely across northeast Scotland.
