Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Another largely windy day is expected, with westerly gales in the southwest, and with gales or severe gales likely across N.Ireland during the evening. Plenty of cloud and a band of rain will push northeastwards across all parts during the day, with snow on the Scottish mountains, and this will be followed by more showery conditions and occasional sunny spells.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Windy, particularly on Wednesday, when gales or severe gales are likely in many parts. Broken cloud will bring some sunny spells and scattered showers generally, but more persistent rain, some heavy, will push northeastwards across England and Wales during Thursday.
