Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A weakening band of rain will cross the United Kingdom today, with patchy light rain throughout much of England clearing the east coast by early afternoon. Much of Scotland will have persistent rain but elsewhere a mixture of sunny intervals and scattered showers. A dry, chilly night for most with some patchy frost, but outbreaks of rain in the northwest.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday will be fine and dry with sunny spells for most, however northern and western Scotland will have periods of rain at times. Monday turns unsettled with a freshening wind and rain reaching most areas, occasionally heavy in the west.
