Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Further showery rain over western parts today will move northwards, lingering across the north overnight. The southeast will be drier, brighter and again locally warm whilst it will remain dull, misty and rather cold in the northeast. Southern parts will have clear intervals overnight with scattered showers further west and areas of mist and low cloud.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday, rain across central and northern parts should become confined to northeastern areas, where it will be cold. Brighter and drier conditions in the south will extend north into central areas and Northern Ireland. Through Saturday, rain in the west will spread northeastwards.
