

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 29 Nov 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers along western coasts, especially across northwest Scotland where some will be heavy and wintry. Overnight wintry showers will spread across northern Scotland and Northern Ireland. Today outbreaks of light rain continuing across southeast England, then overnight the rain will extend across much of central and southern England, turning to sleet in places. Otherwise dry, with widespread fog. Generally cold.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday central and southern England outbreaks of rain, occasionally sleet on higher ground. Wintry showers across northern Scotland and Northern Ireland. Elsewhere dry, areas of fog persisting. Monday rain, sleet or snow for many places, driest in west. Generally cold.
