Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A risk of a little more sleet or snow across parts of southwest England and southeast Wales this morning, but soon clearing. However, most western areas of the UK will see another cloudy and damp day. Brightening up across central and eastern England, but remaining cold, with another locally severe frost tonight. Always milder across the northwest.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Little change on Saturday, with predominantly cloudy and damp, but fairly mild conditions across Scotland and Northern Ireland, and cold and sunny for much of England and Wales. The very cold air should gradually ease away through Sunday, but less sunshine on offer.
