

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across Northern Ireland will gradually extend southeast across Wales and central parts of England. Fine to the south of this for most of today, though slightly cooler than Tuesday with increasing amounts of cloud. Sunny spells with scattered showers to the north of the rainband.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Early rain, locally heavy and perhaps thundery, will clear from East Anglia and southeast England Thursday morning. Broken cloud and scattered showers will follow through the rest of Thursday, and all of Friday, across the UK. Temperatures generally near or slightly below average, and so feeling noticeably cooler across southern England.
