Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain will move northwards, preceded by a spell of snow from Wales and the Midlands northwards. The snow will turn to rain by the afternoon in southern parts of the UK, with some heavy bursts in places. Most of Scotland and Northern Ireland will remain dry, bright and cold but wintry showers continuing in the far northwest.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain and snow in northeast England and Scotland on Saturday, slowly easing away east. Elsewhere, showery rain clearing east, with sunny spells developing and isolated blustery showers, wintry at times. These brighter conditions will spread to all areas by Sunday.
