

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will be dry with sunny spells and, with light winds, it will feel pleasantly warm in the sunshine. Northern Scotland will be cloudier though with occasional rain and hill snow. Snow showers will affect Shetland. Rain and snow will continue in northern Scotland overnight, but it will be dry, clear and cold elsewhere.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Most places will be bright on Sunday, although cloud will gradually increase from the west. Rain and snow will continue over northern Scotland, and rain may affect southwest England later. Further rain is possible in the south on Monday, but it should stay dry elsewhere.
