

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Thickening cloud will gradually spread northwestwards across England and Wales, with wet weather for southeast and central, southern England this afternoon. Largely fine today in the north and west, though damp across northwest Scotland. The rain spreading to much of England and Wales tonight, but largely fine across Scotland and Northern Ireland with frost and fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Fine across Scotland and Northern Ireland on Sunday, but largely cloudy and breezy across England and Wales with occasional light rain. Risk of heavy showers in the far southwest on Sunday. A similar story for Monday, though some rain in the far northwest too.
