

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 04 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain across the north will become confined to northern and eastern Scotland.  
Elsewhere it should become largely dry with sunny spells, and just a few  
showers. Northeastern England will be noticeably warmer than of late. Later this  
evening and overnight, cloud and rain will spread from the southwest, across  
many southern and western parts, with some hill fog developing.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

There will be outbreaks of rain in the west on Saturday, and these could be  
heavy in places. Eastern areas will start dry and bright, although some patchy  
rain will spread here later. Sunday will be windier with rain spreading  
northeastwards.
