Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
The persistent rain, sleet and snow will become increasingly confined to northeast Scotland with further accumulations here. Elsewhere becoming brighter after a cold start but with further heavy, wintry showers in the Westcountry and Wales, falling as snow on hills. Most places cold and frosty tonight with wintry showers.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain and snow will still affect northern Scotland tomorrow. A few wintry showers are likely elsewhere but mainly fine and bright, though rain will arrive near the south coast later, turning to snow inland. Many places seeing outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow on Thursday too.
