Scotland and Northern Ireland, sunny spells and scattered showers. Cloudy with outbreaks of rain across southeastern Britain, clearing away eastwards by evening. Elsewhere, drier, brighter conditions with just one or two showers. Fresher than recently.

Tonight:

Showers affecting northwestern Scotland. Mostly dry elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday:

Showers across Scotland, some heavy in west. Mainly dry with sunny spells elsewhere. Rain reaching Northern Ireland later.
