

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Wednesday 31 Dec 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A widespread frost at first, locally severe in the north, along with patchy fog. This should clear slowly, but many places will remain grey, misty and very cold all day, with perhaps a few light showers in the northeast and far south. Many western areas should be brighter with some sunny spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
There will be little change. It will remain mostly dry with variable cloud and some sunshine, the best of the sunshine likely in the west. However, frost, fog and low cloud may be very persistent in some areas. The far southwest may become a little less cold.
