

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 17 Dec 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold, frosty and, in places, icy start with patchy fog. Scattered rain, sleet and snow showers are expected on the northwesterly breeze, with snow settling at low levels in northern Scotland. There should be some sunshine in eastern Britain though. It will turn very cold and frosty overnight, with scattered wintry showers continuing in westernmost parts of the UK.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Generally much drier and brighter on Sunday with wintry showers less widespread and frequent, but staying cold in the northwesterly wind. Dry and cold at first on Monday but rain will affect all areas by afternoon, introducing some milder air.
