Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Sunny intervals will develop in the south and far west, but across remaining areas it will stay cloudy with hill and coastal mist, fog and drizzle, and with rain at times over eastern Scotland and northeast England. Heavy showers will affect some southern and western parts. Temperatures near normal in the west, but cold again in the east.

Cloudy tonight, further rain in the northeast, other northern and eastern areas drizzly and misty, the west mostly dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Often cloudy with occasional rain, but some drier and brighter spells as well. Staying rather cold and misty near east coasts.
