

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny intervals and showers, some heavy with thunder, and in the south merging into longer spells of rain at times. However, it should turn drier and brighter later this afternoon. It will remain chilly. Tonight, dry and chilly in the north with patchy fog. Further persistent and heavy rain spreading northwards in the south.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Organised rain, often heavy, even torrential, will spread northwards on Friday, accompanied by strong easterly winds. Turning brighter with heavy showers in the southwest for the afternoon. Further rain or showers on Saturday, accompanied by a very chilly and strong north or northeasterly wind.
