Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
A dull start in most places, with extensive mist, patchy fog and low cloud in the east and some central districts. Outbreaks of rain are expected, prolonged across much of Scotland and far north of England, more showery in Northern Ireland. Thicker cloud and rain will spread north across southwest England. Elsewhere, not too much sunshine is expected. Feeling cold where mist persists.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Generally unsettled on Tuesday, with showers or longer spells of rain in many places. By Wednesday, low cloud and rain should be more confined to the east, allowing intervals of warm sunshine in the west and south.
