

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 03 Mar 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Overnight rain and hill snow will continue to clear east but will persist across eastern Scotland. Elsewhere, there will be some sunshine but also showers, heaviest and most frequent across southern areas with the risk of hail, thunder and hill snow. Showers should become lighter overnight with most eastern areas becoming dry, leading to a widespread frost.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Most places will be fine on Tuesday with only isolated showers and plenty of sunshine. Showers will be more frequent across Scotland and persistent rain will affect southwestern areas later. Dry and bright on Wednesday away from rain in the far north.
