

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 13 May 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
After a chilly start most areas will have a fine and warm day but isolated showers are possible, mainly across northeastern Britain. It will feel chilly here with an onshore breeze. Overnight it will gradually become wet across Wales and parts of southern England, with clear spells elsewhere and a patchy rural frost in the north.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

On Thursday rain will continue across the southern half of the UK, where it will feel chilly, but it will be dry further north with sunny spells. Most places will be fine on Friday but wind and rain will move into northwestern Britain later.
