

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 24 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Central and eastern England should be fairly bright and largely dry. Elsewhere, increasing amounts of cloud, with occasional rain or drizzle, especially for western England, Wales and parts of Scotland. Northern Ireland should become drier this afternoon after a damp start. Temperatures will be around normal in light winds.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday will see sunny intervals, but also a scattering of light showers, mainly across eastern England, with more organised rain affecting Scotland later on Sunday and into Monday. England and Wales largely dry on Monday with just the odd shower. Becoming breezy in northwestern areas and turning warmer across southeast England.
