Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A sunny, albeit chilly start for most parts across the UK. It will soon warm up, with variable amounts of cloud developing through the day. The best of the prolonged sunny spells will be found towards western England and Wales. Perhaps the odd light shower developing over northern Scotland. Remaining dry overnight, with clear spells. Winds remaining light throughout.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

It will be another warm day on Monday for Britain, with light winds. Always more cloud towards northwestern areas. Tuesday will be cooler in the west with more unsettled conditions and outbreaks of rain. Remaining warm and sunny in the east.
