Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any mist or fog will clear leaving a generally fine day with warm sunshine and light winds. However, there is a risk of a few showers, mainly in eastern England. Becoming cloudy and windy in the west after dark with outbreaks of rain arriving, some of which will be heavy.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
On Sunday heavy rain will push eastwards, becoming lighter with time. However, it's likely to remain dry in the far east. Monday will be mainly cloudy with some rain and drizzle, especially in the northwest. In the east, some bright spells are likely where it will feel warm and humid.
