Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Winds continue to ease but there are still plenty of showers around.  
These will be heavy and squally, locally thundery, but mixed with  
sunny intervals. The best of the sunshine is likely to be across  
parts of northwest Scotland, Northern Ireland and southern England.  
However, heavy rain will affect eastern Scotland and parts of  
northeast England throughout. Temperatures will be around average.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
During Sunday and Monday there will be further sunshine and showers,  
still locally heavy, but as winds become lighter inland, some  
overnight frost and fog as well. Chilly northeasterly winds will  
spread to the northwest later.
