Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A cloudy start in places on Sunday with some rain. This soon dying away, then mostly dry with some good spells of sunshine developing. Most places dry, although some showers are possible over some central and northern areas in the afternoon. Mostly warm or very warm, and locally hot in the south. Dry overnight, with long clear periods, although some patchy low cloud and mist is likely in places.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Mainly dry with long sunny spells. Cloudier in the far northwest, and here some rain is likely at times. Hot or very hot for many, nearer normal temperatures in cloudier northwest.
