Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Today will be windy with gales in the north easing. There will be sunny spells and showers, the showers mainly in the north and west, and falling as sleet or snow over high ground in the north, giving a covering of snow over Scottish hills.

Staying windy tonight. Mainly dry in the south and east with clear spells but cloud increasing elsewhere to bring outbreaks of rain, heavy and persistent later in Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Dry in the south on Monday, but cloud and rain, locally heavy, in the north will move southeast across all areas on Tuesday, accompanied by squally winds.
