

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 03 Feb 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A cold day with the best of the sunshine across central and western parts.  
However thicker cloud will also bring isolated wintry showers elsewhere. A  
weakening band of sleet and snow will also spread gradually south across the  
northwest. A dry, cold and frosty overnight period follows, with icy patches,  
especially where any localised snow accumulations persist.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cold again Wednesday, although most places dry with some winter sunshine. The  
far northwest and some eastern areas staying cloudier, with further isolated  
sleet or snow showers. Brisk winds with further wintry showers across some  
eastern parts Thursday. Otherwise dry and cold.
