Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Most places will start cold with a widespread sharp frost, and perhaps a few mist patches in the north. Otherwise most places will have a dry day with plenty of sunshine. Later in the day, increasing cloud and wind will spread outbreaks of rain into parts of northwest Scotland. Many places will again be rather cold, but with light winds, but temperatures across Scotland are likely to recover to become mild by the end of the day.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Northern Scotland will be windy and mild with rain at times. The rest of Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will be cloudy, rather breezy, but dry. Elsewhere, it will remain dry and quiet with some sunshine by day, but some frost and patchy fog overnight.
