

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 06 Jan 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Snow showers will continue across northern Scotland giving further accumulations. Persistent rain is expected over southern England, but elsewhere will be dry and cold with clear or sunny spells. Overnight, rain in southern England will spread slowly northwards turning to snow initially, reaching the Midlands by dawn. Most places will be cold and frosty with a risk of ice.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

It will stay unsettled and quite windy, with further outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow. Snow most likely across northern parts of the UK. However, it should become drier on Saturday afternoon and less cold in southern parts of the UK.
