Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scattered showers, some heavy, are expected to develop across Northern Ireland, eastern England and eastern Scotland during the day. Occasional mist or fog may affect western coasts, but it should be drier and brighter elsewhere, and feel warm, especially in southeast England. However, cloud and occasional drizzle may reach parts of southwest England later in the evening.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy, possibly thundery rain is likely across southern parts at first on Sunday, spreading northwards to affect many places during the day. Drier at first on Monday, with further outbreaks of rain spreading eastwards later. It will feel much cooler, with breezy winds.
