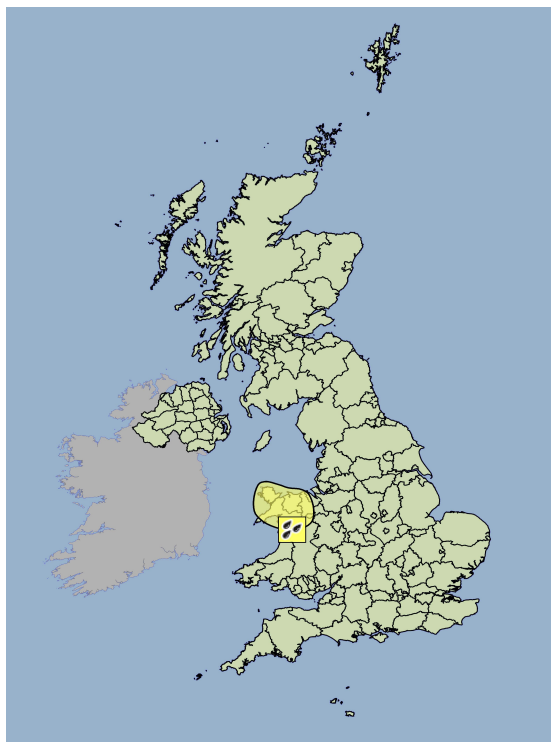




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

And active frontal system will arrive across northern parts of Wales on Saturday associated with strong winds and a stream of very moist air. This system is now expected to be further north than previously forecast and so the southern extent of this warning area has been trimmed compared to the previous issue.

This system is expected to generate some very large rainfall accumulations through Saturday and into Sunday, especially across high ground. 40 to 60 mm could fall quite widely with over 100 mm possible across Snowdonia. Given the saturated state of the ground from recent rainfall, this amount of rain is likely to lead to some flooding.

There continue to be some uncertainties over the position of this system and the duration of the spell of rain and therefore peak totals, so this alert will be kept under review.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Rain**

Valid from **00:15 on Sat, 05th Dec 2015** until **12:00 on Sun, 06th Dec 2015**

Heavy rain is expected to develop on Saturday and persist into Sunday. Given saturated ground and high river levels, be aware of the potential for flooding affecting parts of communities, disruption to travel, and danger to life from fast-flowing deep water.
