Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a rather cloudy start in the southeast, whilst elsewhere there will be some isolated mist or fog patches, especially in the north and west. These will clear to leave another largely fine day with some warm sunny spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Conditions will continue to be largely dry and fine on Friday and Saturday, with the best of the warm sunny spells in the west and more in the way of cloud across eastern parts. It will be a little breezy in the south. Turning chilly during the overnight periods across northern parts, with local mist or fog patches possible.
