Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Partly cloudy with a mix of sunny intervals and scattered showers. The showers most prevalent and heaviest towards the northwest of the United Kingdom, whereas it should remain dry across much of central and eastern Britain. During the evening and night, some heavier bursts of rain are expected to move eastwards across much of Wales and England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Generally fine and chilly on Thursday, though still rather showery across northwest Scotland. All parts dry and predominantly fair on Friday, though generally feeling colder. Frost will become quite widespread at night, with fog likely to form across inland parts of Britain.
