Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern Scotland cloudy with rain with hill snow. Elsewhere, a frosty start, then sunny spells. Wintry showers, especially near western and southern coasts dying out for a time, but further rain or sleet reaching southern counties later. Tonight, Snow for Scotland and Northern Ireland. Heavy sleet or snow spreading northeast across southern England and Wales. Elsewhere, very frosty, patchy fog.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Sunny spells and wintry showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. England and Wales, cloudy with sleet or snow on Thursday with heavy snow for central areas giving deep falls in places. Snow clearing southwards Friday leaving sunshine and wintry showers.
