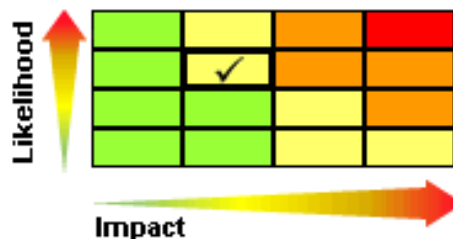
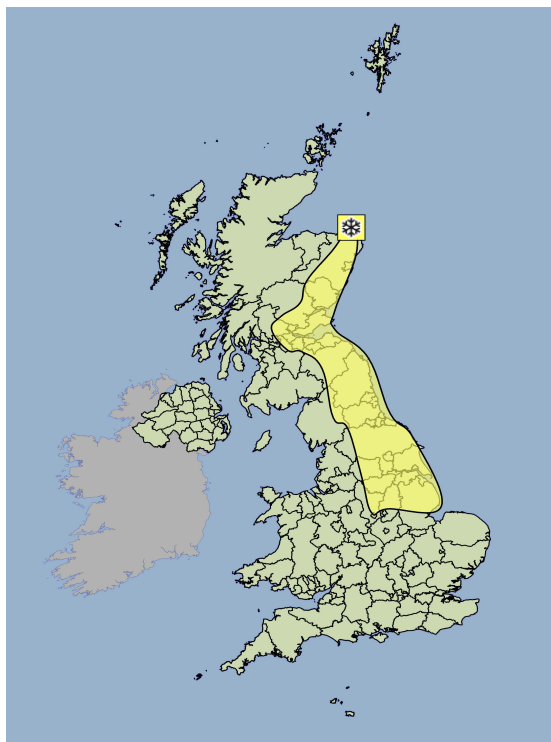




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A very cold easterly airstream will continue to bring showers of snow, hail and sleet into parts of eastern Britain. As temperatures dip below freezing overnight, further localised accumulations of snow are likely along with some icy surfaces.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Snow**

Valid from **20:00 on Tue, 26th Mar 2013** until **09:00 on Wed, 27th Mar 2013**

Snow showers will continue to affect parts of central and eastern Scotland, northeast England and perhaps the Northeast Midlands on Tuesday evening, overnight and into Wednesday morning. 1-2 cm may accumulate in places, with 3-5 cm locally on high ground in the east. In addition, icy patches may affect some surfaces where snow has melted during Tuesday.

Drivers are advised to take extra care and be aware of the risk of some disruption to travel.
