

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Breezy with showers across northern Scotland. Rest of Scotland and Northern Ireland will be often cloudy, but some sunny intervals, along with isolated showers, will develop. England and Wales will be dry and generally sunny, except for becoming cloudy at times across northern England and Wales. Locally very warm again across southern England.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Wednesday outbreaks of rain will spread southeastwards across England and Wales, clearing away south Wednesday night. Cooler conditions with scattered showers already further north, will then spread to all areas for Thursday. The rain or showers may become heavy at times.
