Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers or longer periods of rain will affect many parts of the UK today, although southeast England may stay dry until evening. Feeling cool, and staying breezy in the north. Showers or rain will eventually reach parts of the southeast and East Anglia tonight, where there could be some heavy bursts for a time. Elsewhere should become drier.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Further showers on Saturday, heavy and thundery for a time in eastern parts, but western areas should see fewer showers later. Many places starting dry on Sunday but rain is likely to reach many northern and western parts during the daytime.
