Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Today: Brighter spells will break through in many areas this morning.  
However, showers will develop as well, these becoming heavy in places  
with the risk of localised thundery downpours especially in central,  
southeastern and eastern parts later today.  
Tonight: The south and east will become largely dry with those  
showers dying out, but further showers will spread across northern  
parts later. A few further south.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday: Sunshine and scattered showers in south. Showers more  
prolonged and heavier in the north.

Sunday: Many northern and eastern parts starting dry, but cloud and  
rain will spread across the south through the day.
