

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 01 Nov 2017

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early heavy rain in southwest Scotland will ease, then move southwards, eventually reaching Northern Ireland and the far north of England. Wales and most of England will stay dry, bright and mild, but blustery showers will affect Northern Scotland. The rain in Northern Ireland and northern England will mostly die out overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

After morning fog in the south has cleared, Thursday will be cloudy but mostly dry in Wales and the English Midlands. More sunshine is expected elsewhere, especially in the north. Friday will be mainly dry but cloudy, however, heavy rain is likely in the South overnight.
