

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cloudy start in the north with patchy rain, becoming increasingly dry and bright. Cloudy in the south and west with some patchy rain. Some warm sunny spells towards the southeast with a risk of a few heavy showers later. Overnight will be mainly dry with light winds and clear spells, leading to a chilly night for many.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A chilly start followed by a dry day with sunny spells for many on Saturday, feeling pleasantly warm in the sunshine. However, rain will arrive in the northwest later. Rain spreading southeast across all parts through Sunday, with cooler, brighter conditions following.
