

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Good Friday will start generally cloudy with patchy fog and outbreaks of rain. Central and eastern areas will remain grey and damp throughout today. Skies will brighten in the west later, although it will become breezy here. Clear spells will develop in the west and across southern Scotland overnight. Elsewhere it will remain cloudy with some light rain. Generally frost-free.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rather cloudy with patchy rain in the southeast and northwest on Saturday. Mostly dry elsewhere with some sunny intervals. Further patchy rain in the northwest on Sunday, but fine elsewhere with light winds and some pleasantly warm spells of sunshine.
