

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 09 Mar 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across central areas will slowly edge south and turning increasingly to snow, giving accumulations even to lower levels. It will be brighter but showery across southwestern Britain and clearer but colder to the north. Overnight, rain and snow across central areas will weaken. Largely dry away from rain affecting the southwest but cold with widespread frost and icy patches.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain will spread into southwestern areas through Sunday, turning to snow overnight and through Monday giving accumulations in places. Drier and brighter elsewhere but with occasional snow showers. Bitterly cold across the UK with widespread frost and ice in places.
