

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 02 May 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be dry across northern and eastern Britain with some hazy sunshine but rain and brisk winds will slowly spread from the southwest, affecting most of England, Wales and Northern Ireland by evening. Rain will become heavy overnight and continue northeastwards bringing strong winds, perhaps gales in places, and hill snow across northern Scotland.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Wind and rain will reach the Northern Isles by Sunday evening, with hill snow across mainland northeast Scotland. Brighter conditions will follow with a few heavy, thundery showers. It will be much drier on Monday but heavy, perhaps thundery rain may affect southern Britain later.
