Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many areas will be dry and sunny on Tuesday after a cold, frosty start. Some showers will continue to affect western coasts and hills through the day, and these will be wintry over northern hills. Feeling cold in the sometimes brisk northwesterly breeze.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Many inland areas will be dry and sunny on Wednesday, but chilly with scattered showers on coasts, these wintry over northern hills, and possibly persistent on east coasts for a time with brisk northwesterly winds. Outbreaks of rain, sleet or snow will spread to western areas later on Thursday, but drier and brighter in the east.
